**From I-287 South:** (From Morristown Area): Take I-287-S to I-78 West. Proceed on I-78 W for approx. 3 miles to Exit 26 (Lamington/North Branch). At traffic light at off ramp make a left onto Rattlesnake (county road 665) which turns into Lamington Road.

**Lamington Road:** Take Lamington Road for 2.3 miles. The side entrance to Raritan Valley Community College will be on the left. You may enter the side entrance to the college. To enter college from main entrance continue straight on Lamington Road. At traffic light make a left onto Easton Turnpike (county road 614).
