## **Important Information from Princeton University**

In order to comply with Princeton Fire Marshall regulations and building codes:

- Absolutely no **chairs**, **coolers** or **large duffle bags** will be allowed to pass through the general admission gate, or to be placed in the spectator seating area.
- No glass containers are permitted anywhere in the DeNunzio natatorium.
- The natatorium will be cleared of **all spectators** after each day's mid-day distance event session (400 IMs & 500 Freestyles).
- Swimmers who are swimming in both the mid-day session and the afternoon session will not have to leave the building.
- Swimmers competing in the afternoon session only will not be admitted until the swimmers' entrance opens for the afternoon session.
- Swimmers and spectators are asked to please plan accordingly, depending on the weather conditions on the day.

## **Entrance Fees**

## Two separate entrance fees will be collected on Saturday and Sunday for this meet:

- One for the morning 12 & Under session, which will allow attendance until the end of the mid-day distance session, when the building will be cleared.
- One for the afternoon 13 & Over session. Spectators arriving for the mid-day distance session will **not** have to pay again for the afternoon session. They will have to leave the building when it is cleared at the end of the distance session, but will be re-admitted through the turnstiles without paying an additional entrance fee.
